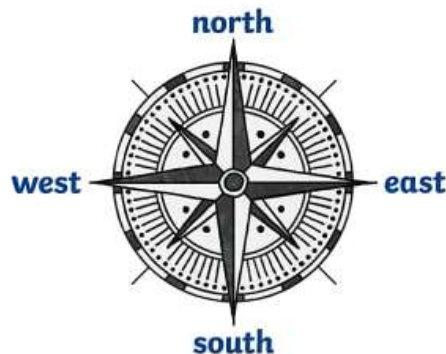


Year 1: Shiver Me Timbers

Key vocabulary	Definitions
pirate	A sailor who attacks other ships at sea and steals their property.
country	A large area of land where people live under the same government.
city	Larger than a town where many people live closely together.
compass	A tool to help with finding direction.
material	A word to describe what something is made of e.g. wood, plastic or metal.
sort	To put objects into groups according to similar or different characteristics.
flexibility	An object's ability to easily bend without breaking.
absorbency	An object's ability to soak up liquid.
waterproof	A word to describe something that keeps water out. If water cannot pass through an object or material, it is waterproof.
island	A piece of land surrounded by water.
symbol	A picture/image to represent human and physical features on a map.

Objects which are made from cotton.



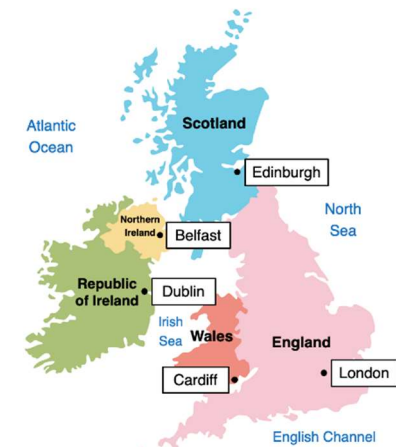
Clothing which is suitable to wear in wet weather.
