









# Habitats

Key vocabulary	Definitions and Key Knowledge
 microhabitat	A microhabitat is a very small habitat in places like under a rock, under leaves or on a branch. Minibeasts live in microhabitats.
 depend	Many living things in a habitat depend on each other. This means they need each other for different things.
 survive	This means to stay alive.
plant 	Plants need water, sunlight and carbon dioxide to stay healthy.
seed 	Seeds are planted in the soil usually but sometimes are sprinkled on the top. It depends on the type of plant.
germination 	When a plant bursts out of its shell it is called germination.
shoot 	Some plants lean towards the sunlight.
