






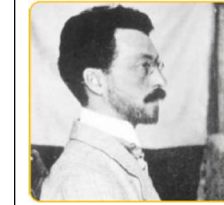

Roald Dahl (1916 - 1990) a famous British children's author.

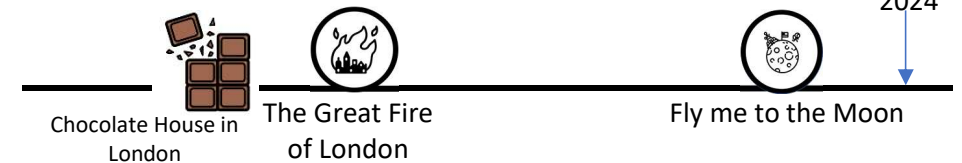
### History of chocolate timeline
