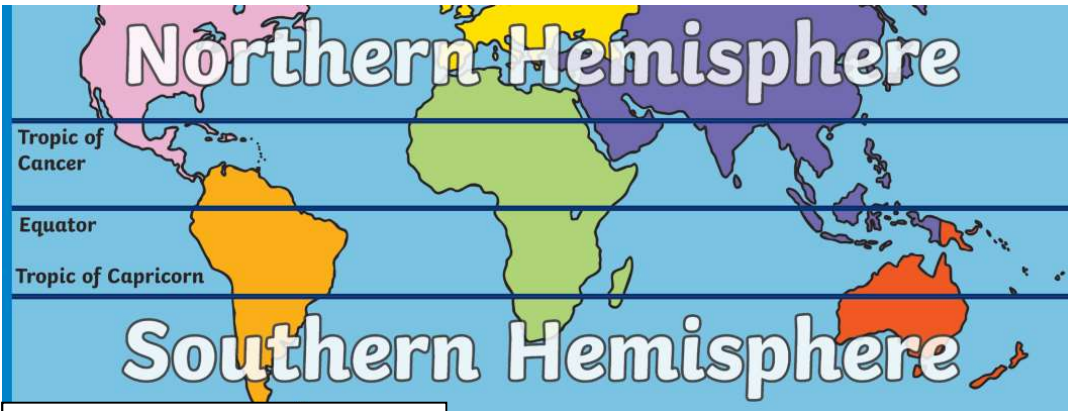

Knowledge:

- I can name and locate some of the main Islands, including the Isle of Wight, Guernsey, Jersey, the Isle of Man, the Hebrides, the Orkneys and the Shetland Isles
- The British Isles consists of all the islands.
- The U.K. consists of England, Northern Ireland, Scotland and Wales.
- Great Britain consists of England, Scotland and Wales.
- An ethnic group describes people from a common cultural background. Some ethnic groups in the U.K.: white, Gypsy/travelers, Asian (Indian, Pakistani, Bangladeshi, Chinese), Mixed.
- Six cities in England: Bristol, Manchester, Liverpool, Newcastle, London and Birmingham.
- The countries of the U.K. and their capital cities: England, London; Wales, Cardiff; Scotland, Edinburgh; Northern Ireland, Belfast.
- I can describe some physical features of each country: England - the Lake District, Lake Windermere, Scafell Pike, the Pennines, the River Thames, the Mersey and the Tyne. Scotland - Ben Nevis
- Brighton used to be a fishing village, but King George turned it into a holiday resort in the 1780s.
- Features of Brighton include the Royal Pavilion, the i360, Brighton Beach, the piers and the South Downs.



In this topic, children learn about the make-up of the British Isles. They also learn traditional stories from different parts of the U.K., related to dragons. Children are expected to focus on an aspect of history from a local city, in this case, Brighton. They study the history of the Royal Pavilion and its colourful owner, George IV.
