## Knowledge:

- I can explore the different learning challenges based around fairytales within each area of the inside and outside classroom.
- 2. I can name and talk about my likes and dislikes of 3 classic fairytales (Jack and the Beanstalk, The Three Little Pigs, Little Red Riding Hood).
- 3. I can retell a simple version of 'Jack and the Beanstalk', 'The Three Little Pigs' and 'Little Red Riding Hood' using the words beginning, middle and end.
- 4. I can plant a seed and understand that we need soil, water and sunlight in order for it to grow.
- 5. I can observe a beanstalk growing over time and compare and talk about which ones are the tallest/shortest.
- 6. I can explore and test a range of materials to see which are the strongest for making a house for the pigs.
- 7. I can take on a role in my play to act out the story of 'The Three Little Pigs', using key vocabulary from the book.
- 8. I know the key features of a poster and can create a missing poster for 'Granny'.
- I can use positional language to guide Little Red Riding Hood through the woods.
- 10. I can follow instructions from a recipe to make rice crispie cakes for Granny.

#### Skills:

- To explore the different areas of learning within the inside and outside environment.
- To be able to name and talk about 3 fairytales.
- To be able to retell a simple version of 'Jack and the Beanstalk', 'The Three Little Pigs' and 'Little Red Riding Hood'.
- To plant a seed and understand what is needed in order for it to grow.
- To observe a beanstalk growing over time and compare the different sizes.
- To explore which materials are best for building a house for the pigs.
- To take on a role in their play to act out the story of 'The Three Little Pigs'.
- To know the key features of a poster.
- To be able to use positional language.
- To follow a recipe to make a cake.
