





Our Homework


Times Tables

School P.E kit is:


- Plain black shorts or tracksuit bottoms

4. Expectations for school uniform


4.1 Our school's uniform

All our pupils are expected to wear school uniform. The only uniform items that we ask pupils to wear which display a school logo are the school sweatshirt and cardigan.

- Dark grey skirt/trousers/shorts
- White polo shirt (Years R 2)
- White shirt (Years 3 6)
- Purple sweatshirt/cardigan with school logo
- Black shoes
- Purple check summer dress
- School tie (Years 3-6) Available from the school office only




Attendance
