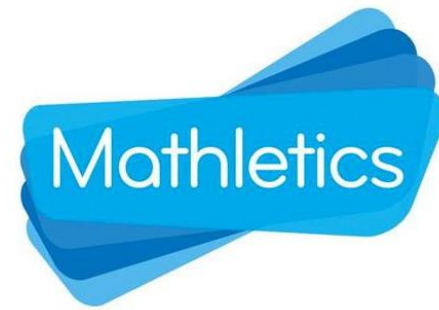

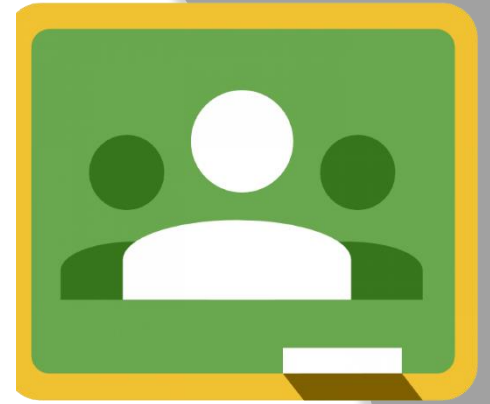
Spellings, topic & creative homework tasks will be set on dB Primary/Google Classroom and a photograph or document of the homework should be uploaded!

- ⦿ Lessons and homework will be set via Google Classroom (2023)



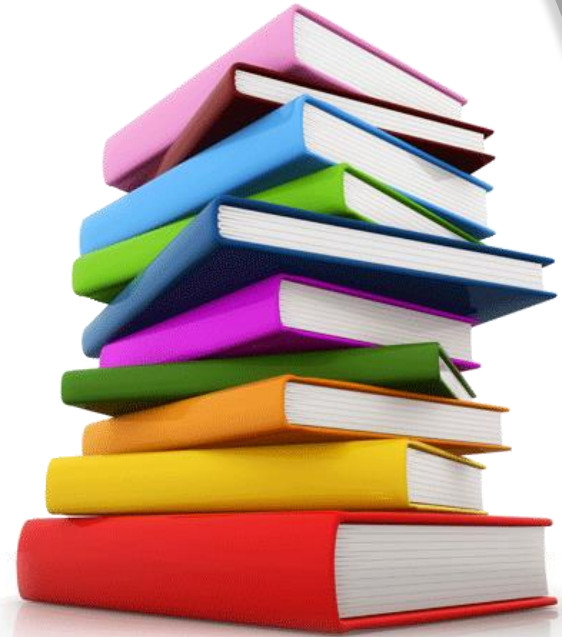
PE

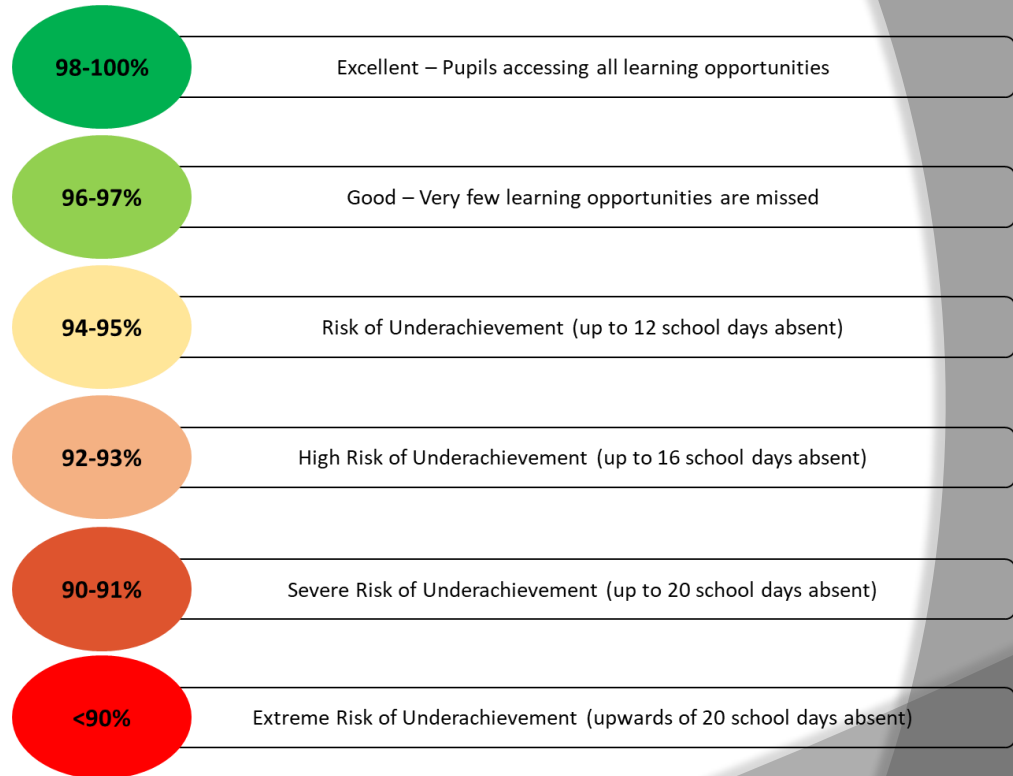
ATTENDANCE

Attendance
