Top tips for successful reading at home:

- Limit distractions i.e. TV off!
- Find a time which is good for you and your child where you have time to listen
- Encourage them to use the pictures to tell the story. This is a very important skill.
- Can they spot any of the letter sounds we have been learning at school in the book title?
- Praise your child for having a go, make sure they realise how much you love to hear them read.

Also, try to find time to read your child a bedtime story. The most important part of reading is enjoyment, developing a love of books will turn them into successful readers

Please write a comment in your child's 'Reading Record' book when they have read with you. This helps us to know that their books need changing and also gives us an understanding of how they are getting or reading at home with you.
