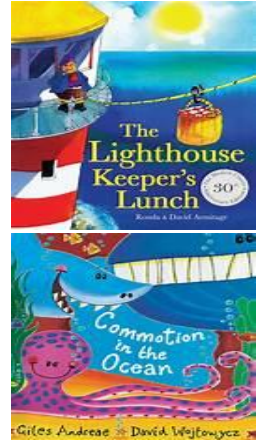
Week Beginning: 6/6/22

Our new topic for this half term is 'Beside the Seaside.'

For the next few weeks we are focussing on lighthouses and sea animals.

The book that will help us with our learning is 'The Lighthouse Keepers Lunch.' We will be writing a shopping list for the Lighthouse Keeper, Mr Grinling's lunch. It may include mustard sandwiches!

The other book we will use is 'Commotion in the Ocean.' We will write sentences to describe a range of sea animals.



The phonics we are working on reading and writing are:

ar, or, ur, ow, oi, ear, air, ure, er, ai

We are learning that two letters that make one sound are called 'digraphs'. We are also learning that three letters that make one sound are called 'trigraphs.'

We are working on writing the letters correctly and using them in our reading and writing independently.



Maths:

In Maths we are learning about subtraction. We are using pictures and the language of first, then, now to describe what is happening.

For example, in subtraction: 'First there were 6 bottles on the wall, then 2 get knocked down, how many are on the wall now?' (6-2=4)
