We are in our final weeks of our topic 'All the fun of the Fair!'


For the next few weeks, we are focussing on the Circus. We are learning how to perform circus skills such as balancing, dancing and juggling. We will also be focussing on clowns and the way they can make the audience laugh. We are writing a descriptive sentence about a clown using a range of adjectives. The book that will help us with our learning is 'The Fabulous Foskett Family Circus'.



This half term we are reviewing all of the letter sounds that we have learnt so far.

We are developing our ability to read cccvcc words (consonantconsonant-consonant-vowelconsonant-consonant) i.e. splint, string

We are working on writing the letters correctly and using them in our reading and writing with growing independence.





Maths:

In Maths we have been learning about addition and subtraction. We are using pictures and the language of first, then, now to describe what is happening.

For example, in addition: 'First there were 4 people on the bus, then 4 more get on, how many people are on the bus now?' (4+4=8). We are looking at how we can record/write these numbers and symbols.



Here is a reminder of how we write our letters in school. Some letters stay on the grass, some go up into the sky and some go down into the mud. CHALLENGE - Can they have a go at writing our phonics sounds?
