



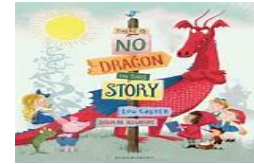
Foundation Stage News

Look out there are dragons about! We were very excited to discover dragon footprints and an egg in our class this week. We even thought we had spotted a dragon flying high in the sky!

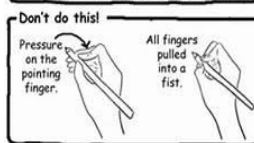
We will be using the books 'Dragon Post' and 'There's no Dragon in this Story' to help us to understand more about dragons. We will writing letters and making posters to help us in our dragon research. We will also be making dragon masks, so watch out! You may have your own little dragon coming home soon.



This half term we are reviewing all of the letter sounds that we have learnt so far.

We are learning that two letters that make one sound are called 'digraphs'. We are also learning that three letters that make one sound are called 'trigraphs'.

We are working on writing the letters correctly and using them in our reading and writing with growing independence.
