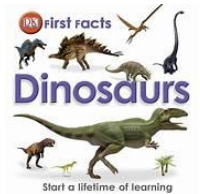
St Francis Class

We have a new and exciting topic for this half term - 'Fantastic Beasts!' We will be finding out about dinosaurs, dragons and minibeasts!

For the next few weeks we will be focussing on dinosaurs. We will be reading dinosaur poems and using non-fiction texts to find out dinosaur facts.

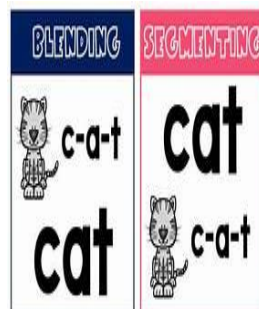
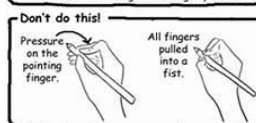
We will be using the books 'Mad about Dinosaurs' and 'First Facts: Dinosaurs'.



This half term we are reviewing all of the letter sounds that we have learnt so far.

We are learning that two letters that make one sound are called 'digraphs'. We are also learning that three letters that make one sound are called 'trigraphs'.

We are working on writing the letters correctly and using them in our reading and writing with growing independence.

Maths:

In St Francis' class we have worked through the numbers 0 to 10. We are continuing to look at representing the number, comparing numbers and the composition of each number i.e. how the number is made. We have also looked at one more and one less.

Through this the children are developing a great understanding of number and they are using this to solve simple problems.
