Identified gaps in learning

Maths – gaps in knowledge and coverage partially due to missed schooling during the lockdown
 Writing stamina and fluency have dipped and the standard use of grammar has fallen due to missed schooling during the lockdown
 Reading habits have been lost during the lockdown – affecting attainment

Year 6 and Year 2 prioritised initially – gaps identified through the use of Teacher Assessment, SATs and NFER tests
