

English

Our Key Texts for this topic are: Stone Age Boy, Animal Superheroes and limericks by Edward Lear.

Writing and performing a play - We will be taking part in role-play activities. We will learn what a script looks like and how we can write our own.

Non-chronological reports - We will be writing our own information texts about an animal we have designed that could have lived in the Stone Age.

Limericks - We will be learning about the structure of a limerick and writing our own.

Maths

Place Value - We will be learning to represent and partition numbers up to 1,000. We will be developing our understanding of number lines and will be able to compare numbers. We will also learn to count in 50s.

Addition and Subtraction - We will learn to add and subtract 1s, 10s and 100s, spotting the patterns when we do this. We will learn some new written methods for addition and subtraction, recognising what happens when we have to cross the 10 or 100. We will learn what the "inverse" is and how this can help us to check our work.

Music

In our Music lessons we will be learning "Let your Spirit Fly". We will be able to appraise music as well as learn how to improvise and compose our own pieces.

Art

In Art we will be experimenting with chinks, charcoals and sketching pencils. We will be learning to show facial expressions in our work, when creating our own Stone Age portraits.

Computing

In our Computing lessons we will be learning how to use the internet for research. We will learn how to copy and paste images and start to create a Powerpoint.

Geography

In Geography, we will be learning about the compass directions North, South, East and West. We will be learning about Salisbury and its physical features (such as the River Avon) and human features (such as Stonehenge and Salisbury Cathedral).

RE

Homes - We will be exploring how God is present in every home. We will be learning how love binds a family together through good times and hard times.

Promises - We will be learning about the promises made at Baptism and at Confirmation and how these are a call to new life.

PE

In PE this half-term we will be learning cricket with our specialist coach, Lara. We will also be developing our fundamental skills including balancing, jumping for height and distance, catching and throwing.

Science

In our Science lessons this half-term, we are focusing on rocks. We will be able to group rocks with similar characteristics. We will also be able to describe rocks as sedimentary and igneous. We will be developing our scientific enquiry skills.
