

English

Our Key Texts for this topic are: Grimm's Fairytales, Jack's Beanstalk Stinks and Instructions.

Wishing Tale (Narrative) - We will be reading lots of different fairytales, including some from different points of view. We will be writing our own wishing tales, focusing on characters.

Instructions - We will be reading Instructions by Neil Gaiman and following our own set of instructions. We will be writing our own instructions for finding a plant that we have designed ourselves.

Maths

Time - We will look at different measures of time including how many days are in a year. We will be comparing durations.

Shape - We will be learning new ways to describe 2D and 3D shapes, such as parallel lines, right angles and perpendicular lines. We will be learning how to make 3D shapes.

Statistics - We will be learning about pictograms and how the pictures can represent different amounts. We will learn how to draw and interpret bar graphs. We will also be learning how to collect data.

Music



We will **listen and appraise** Piano Concerto Allegro Maestoso by Franz Liszt. We will look further at the notation related to the pieces we have learned on the recorder so far in order to understand further the **structure of written music**.

Flower Power

Art

In Art we will be looking at artwork by **Monet**. We will be learning about his impressionists art style and replicating some of his work. We will be using **oil paints** to create our own artwork of our local area in the style of Monet on canvasses.

DT

Grow cress and herbs and use them in a healthy eating recipe. We will be **making a variety of salads** with attention to the way it looks, tastes and meets the requirements of a **balanced meal**.

Geography

In Geography, we will be continuing to look at weather in different parts of the world. We will be exploring plants in our local area and **creating a map** with the locations on. We will also be learning **4-figure grid references and the points of a compass**.

RE

This half term's topic is titled **Dialogue and Encounter**. In this topic they will learn about how Jewish families celebrate Passover today and simple facts about Islam. We will look at the history of the Hebrew people and how they were freed from slavery in Egypt. The five pillars of Islam will be a focus and how people live out their lives using these pillars.

PE

In PE this half-term we will be focusing on **cricket and orienteering**.

Science

In our Science lessons this half-term, we are learning about **plants**. We will be learning about the different parts of flowering parts and the role these different parts play. We will also be learning about how water is absorbed by plants and the best conditions for plants to grow. We will look at the plant life cycle, including how seeds and pollen are transported by insects and birds. We will be building upon our scientific enquiry skills in a range of **experiments**.
