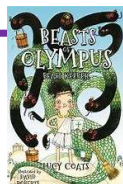


English

In Guided Reading we will be studying **Beasts of Olympus** where we will identify the actions of a quest story. This will be reinforced by our work in writing on **quest stories** from the Ancient Greeks. We will be telling original stories in our own words and writing quest stories that we have planned by adapting ideas from Greek Myths. We will be paying particular attention to **sentence structure** in this initial half term.



Maths

Times tables are a big focus in Year 4 as towards the end of the year we have a government set test, therefore we will be starting the year with a big push in this area. We will be studying **place value** to ensure a solid basis on which to achieve further understanding. Speed of mental calculations will also be a focus in order to move onto multi-step problems.



Music

We will be using the Charanga programme to learn the song **Mamma Mia** by ABBA and also consolidate the notes a, b and g on the recorder.



RE

Our first topic is titled **Creation and Covenant**. This covers the story of Abraham and its relevance to the sacrifice made by Jesus.
