EYFS - Autumn 2

TOPIC: Journey (4 weeks) + Colour (2 weeks)

Quality Texts:

- 'Journey'
- 'Where the Wild Things are'
- 'If I built a Car'
- 'My Many Coloured Day'
- 'Mixed'

Vocabulary:

Christmas, decorate.

Journey, adventure, explore, forest, kingdom, travel, magic, crayon, draw, bird, magic carpet, hot air balloon, boat, explore, knight, king, friend, airplane, fly, security, airport, luggage, suitcase, check in, island, travel, design, car.









Communication and Language:

- We will be using our imagination to re-tell the stories using small world resources.
- · We will focus on adding more detail in describing events and using our growing vocabulary.

Personal, Social and Emotional Development:

Colour, mix, colour mixing, painting, feelings, emotions,

- · We will be learning about how we are the same and different. We will be celebrating the ways that we are all special.
- · We will be learning how to describe and manage our feelings.
- · We will learn about our choices and how we can say sorry and forgive.

Physical Development:

- · We are continuing to develop our fine motor skills, in particular this half term we are thinking about how we hold a pencil correctly.
- · Our PE lessons in the hall are focussing on 'Movement Development', where we will travel in a range of ways, balancing and climbing and thinking about how we can negotiate space successfully.

Literacy:

- We will use our imaginations to write about what we would find behind our own red door.
- We will write a recount of our plane journey.
- · We will write our own colour poem.

Maths:

In our Maths for this half term:

- We will be representing, comparing and learning about the composition of the numbers 1, 2 and 3. We will also be focussing on circles and triangles and using positional language.
- We will be representing numbers up to 5 and learning about one more and one less. We will also be learning about four sided shapes and time.

Understanding of the World:

- We will be comparing Littlehampton with 'Monster Island' and making our own maps.
- · We will be finding out about the past when we learn about Remembrance Day.
- · We will be learning about the season of Winter.

Expressive Arts and Design:

- · We will use our imaginations to paint a picture of what we would find behind our own red door.
- · We will use instruments to represent the journey Max went on in 'Where the Wild Things are'.
- · We will explore colour and colour mixing.



RE:

Our RE for this half term is called 'Prophecy and Promise':

· We will be learning that God gave us his Son Jesus because he loves us. We will learn all about the Nativity story and the events that led up to the birth of Jesus which we celebrate on Christmas day.



Rationale:

This half term we are using our imagination to go on journeys! We will think about the journey the girl went on in the book 'Journey', we will imagine we are with Max on his journey to Monster Island in 'Where the Wild Things Are', we will be designing our own car for our travels and we will prepare to go on a flight to journey around the World! We will finish the half term by exploring colour - by associating colour with our feelings, by finding out how to mix colours and by thinking about the colours we see at Christmas time.
