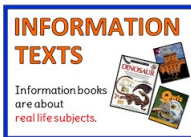


English

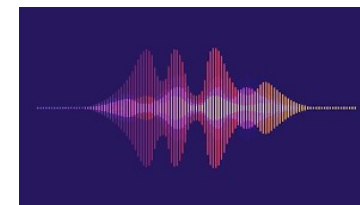
Music
