

Mathematics

In mathematics the children will be thinking about addition and subtraction to 20. We will be learning number bonds and solving word problems involving addition and subtraction strategies. We will be continuing to learn about the place value of numbers to 50 (i.e. there are 3 tens and 5 ones in the number 35 etc).

RE

The RE this half of the term will be based on two key areas of Special People and Meals. In both areas the children will listen to the Word of God and be given the time to reflect on his message, as well as relating it to their own daily life.

English

In English we will continue to ensure all children are reading and writing a range of high frequency words with confidence. The children will also be working towards using a wider range of vocabulary and punctuation in their writing. The children will be reading a range of different stories, poems and non-fiction books about the Polar Explorer Robert Scott and the Polar Region.

Science

The children will be learning about the Seasons and the weather. We will be looking at how animals adapt to the weather in the winter cold conditions and how the lengths of the day change within the seasons.

Computing

The children will be learning that information exists in a variety of forms as well as using ICT to carry out research and using algorithms to program a Bee-Bot.

Art

This term the children will be looking at the artist Ted Harrison who produced work on horizons and landscapes. We will create our own South Pole inspired landscape with drawing and collage techniques.

PE

The children will be learning skills in how to play hockey. Such as showing control with the hockey stick and passing the ball to each other and moving fluently.

History

This term the children will be learning about events beyond living memory that are significant nationally or globally. The focus for this will be Sir Robert Scott of the Antarctic. Children will have access to different sources of information to learn about this significant explorer.

Music

The children will be focusing on exploring pitch (i.e. high and low) when singing.

Geography

The children will be learning skills in how to be a good explorer. We will learn about the locations of the North and South Pole. We will also learn about compass directions.
