

Mathematics

- Multiplication and division - making equal groups, sharing, grouping, dividing by 2, 5 and 10, odd and even numbers, solving word problems.
- Statistics - Making tally charts, creating pictograms, interpreting data and block diagrams.
- Measurement - Measuring in centimeters and metres, comparing lengths, ordering heights and lengths.
- Geometry - properties of shape - Recognising 2D and 3D shapes, sides, vertices, faces, symmetry, patterns and sorting.

English

- Traditional tales - recurring literary themes of traditional African tales.

- Research and write a non-chronological report based on an African Animal
