

## Mathematics

- *Position and direction* - describing movement, describing turns and making patterns with shapes.
- *Problem solving and efficient methods* - using numberfacts, a hundred square, missing numbers, mental addition and subtraction.
- *Time* - How many minutes in an hour. How many hours in a day. Telling and writing time to the hour, the half hour, the quarter hour and five minutes. Finding and comparing durations of time.

## English

- *Familiar Stories* - recurring literary themes.
- Reading and writing report texts about life in Castles.
- Write a setting and character description.
- Reading and writing shape poems about Castles.
- Guided reading.
- Individual reading.

## Science

- Use scientific words related to materials
- Explore changing shapes and materials.
- Identify and compare the uses of materials.
- *Scientific enquiry* - use senses to answer questions, compare several things, suggest how to find things out, organize things and find patterns, record observations and measure using simple equipment.

## Art

- Learn about the work of Paul Klee and create a painting using tints.
- Use new tint skills to create a castle sunset.
- Use collage to create a collage in the style of Paul Klee's painting 'Flora in the Sand.'
- Create royal portraits inspired by the painting 'Senecio' by Paul Klee.
- Design a castle picture using crayon, watercolour and Paul Klee's 'Castle and Sun' painting for inspiration.

## History

- Talk about ideas of 'before you were born', 'when you were younger' etc.

- Use research skills by using a variety of sources (books, internet, people) to find out about castles.
