

Mathematics

Children will multiply and divide fractions, multiply and divide by 10, 100 and 1000, represent decimals and percentages as fractions, multiply and divide decimals as well as representing patterns using algebra.

Science

Children will find out about the process of evolution: animals and plants have changed over time through the process of natural selection. They will also consider how environmental variables affect plants.

Music

In music we will learn a variety of songs as well as body percussion.

ICT

In ICT we will create a maths quiz using Scratch.

PE

This term we will be playing hockey outdoors.

English

We will read Shackleton's Journey by William Grill, who will be visiting the school as part of our project. They will also read Hatchet by Gary Paulsen as well as other short stories with the theme of survival. Children will learn how to use these stories as models for their own writing. In addition, they will learn about the perfect tense and relative clauses as well as developing their understanding of prefixes and word roots.
